Boardwalks and easy access walks

Holkham Beach

A short walk (1 mile). A boardwalk leads to a specially designed viewing platform suitable for wheelchairs, giving stunning views of the beach. There is also a walk accessed via a ramp, this takes you alongside woodland and a natural pool. Both these walks are accessible from Holkham beach car park.

There is a way marked route which is suitable for wheelchairs and pushchairs, there is also disabled access to the visitors centre and there are adapted toilet facilities.

Wells-next-the-Sea

A 2-mile circular walk, being a flat straight walk alongside the harbour/ salt marshes on a tarmac path. Either start at the quay in Wells or at the pay or display car park at the end of Beach Road.
