- look at how many of each type of home we let over each of the last 5 years
- search for the number of homes by property type and area.


This information may help you to choose areas to bid in, as you will be able to see where and how frequently properties arise. This information is updated whenever new developments are completed, and as and when homes are let.

### At a glance
