NOTICE OF ADOPTION

Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004

The Town and Country Planning (Local Development) (England) Regulations 2004

In accordance with Regulation 24(4) and Regulation 36 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Development) (England) Regulations 2004, notice is given that North Norfolk District Council formally adopted its Statement of Community Involvement (SCI) on 26th April 2006.

The SCI is a formal statement of the District Council's policy for involving interested parties in preparing the Local Development Documents to be included in the North Norfolk District Local Development Framework (LDF) and for consulting on planning applications.

Copies of the adopted SCI are available for inspection at North Norfolk District Council Offices in Fakenham, Cromer and North Walsham during normal office hours. Copies are also available at all main libraries and mobile libraries operating in the district. Please call individual libraries for opening times. Copies of the adopted SCI can be viewed on the Council's website (www.northnorfolk.org/ldf) or obtained free of charge by contacting (01263) 516318.

Any person aggrieved by the SCI may make an application to the High Court under Section 113 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004. Any challenge pursuant to Section 113 must be made on the grounds that the document is not within the appropriate power or a procedural requirement has not been complied with. An application under Section 113 must be made not later than the end of the period of six weeks starting from 26th April 2006.

Any person aggrieved by the SCI may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for Judicial Review of the decision to adopt the statement. Any such application must be made promptly and in any event not later than 3 months from 26th April 2006.
