What's it all about?

As part of the production of the Site Specific Proposals Development Plan Document, the Council is seeking your views on a range of potential development sites in Bacton, Happisburgh, Mundesley, Overstrand and Weybourne. The Council wants to hear your opinions on the suitability of the identified sites and whether or not you agree that they represent the most appropriate locations for new development in your village.

Only a small number of these sites will be required for development and therefore the Council has identified its 'Preferred Options'. These are the sites that the Council considers to be the most appropriate at this stage, but these may change as a result of this consultation.
