BRECKLAND COUNCIL CRIMINAL JUSTICE AND POLICE ACT 2001

THETFORD: ORDER TO PREVENT THE CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOL IN DESIGNATED PUBLIC PLACES

Breckland Council intends to make an Order designating the areas shown below under Section 13 of the Criminal Justice and Police Act 2001. The effect of the Order will be to enable a police officer who reasonably believes that a person is, or has been consuming or is about to consume intoxicating liquor in a designated public place to ask that person not to do so and to surrender the liquor. Any person failing to comply, without reasonable excuse, will be committing an arrestable offence. The areas proposed for designation would extend the area covered by the existing Order, which applies to Town Centre Open spaces bounded by the old A11, Hurth Way, the northern edge of Melford Common, Castle Street (excluding the eastern portion of Castle Meadow), Nuns Bridges Road, Mill Lane and Bury Road. The new Order would cover all public open space within the following areas:

ADOPTION STATEMENT

CORE STRATEGY DEVELOPMENT PLAN DOCUMENT
(INCORPORATING DEVELOPMENT CONTROL POLICIES)
and PROPOSALS MAP

The North Norfolk Core Strategy Development Plan Document and Proposals Map were adopted by North Norfolk District Council at its Full Council committee on 24th September 2008.

The Core Strategy sets out the vision, objectives, spatial development strategy and overarching policies that will guide development in the District to 2021. It also comprises a set of Development Control policies for the determination of planning applications. The Proposals Map illustrates the policies on an Ordnance Survey map base.

Any person aggrieved by the Core Strategy DPD or Proposals Map may make an application to the High Court under section 113 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 on the grounds that:


