The following is some of the wildlife I have seen on and around my property :-

The birds that inhabit the surroundings :- Various Sparrows, Dunnock, Hedge Sparrow, Blackbird, Starling, Redwing, Redstart, Song Thrush, Missel Thrush, Fieldfare, Skylark, Waxwing, Robin, Nightingale, Spotted Flycatcher, Bullfinch, Greenfinch, Chaffinch, Hawfinch, Goldfinch, Yellowhammer, Whitethroat, Blackcap, Linnets, Brambling, Lesser Redpoll, Chiffchaff, Warbler, Wheatear, Whinchat, Stonechat, Crossbill, Blue Tit, Great Tit, Long Tailed Tit, Bearded Tit, Coal Tit, Firecrest, Goldcrest, Wren, Pied Wagtail, Grey Wagtail, Yellow Wagtail, Pheasant, Partridge, Corncrake, Lapwing, Woodcock, Pigeon, Wood Pigeon, Turtle Dove, Jay, Magpie, Cuckoo, Jackdaw, Rook, Crow, Kestrel, Merlin, Sparrow Hawk, Barn Owl, Tawny Owl, Heron, Egret, Kingfisher, Reed Bunting, Spotted, Green and Pied Woodpecker, Swift, Swallow, House Martin, Swan, Mallard Ducks, Canadian Goose, Greylag Goose, Moorhen, Coot, various Seagulls.

Animal life :- Hedgehog, Fox, Roe Deer, Squirrel, Stoat, Weasel, Doormouse, Water Vole, Mole, Rat, Grass Snake, Lizards, Frogs, Toads, Newts Common and Crested, plus the river life which must include various types of stuff including Sticklebacks, Redthroats and Carp.

Bats of various kinds.

Butterflies, Red Admiral, Painted lady, Cabbage White, Orange Tip, Meadow Blue, Meadow Brown, plus numerous others and Moths.

Wildflowers and Insects, which must be numerous to be able to support such a wide variety of birds.

I have seen many birds that have been seen passing over, lately the Red Kite.

Many breed in this area as it has over the years been a sanctuary for them all.

A quiet undisturbed place.

You may have noticed protected species are amongst some of these I have mentioned. But this did not stop a J.C.B. from the A.W.A. disturbing the adjacent area during breeding season.

The site is also been reported as important to the - E.U - English Heritage - Defra - R.S.P.B. - N.D.C. - N.N.D.C. - R.P.C. & others.

It is six hundred and thirty one paces from the site to the bus stop by the New Inn.

Central services are generally noted as the bus stops for Cromer & Norwich.

(I have since learnt that the J.C.B. was working on behalf of Mr. Mermagen the property developer.)



The other site **ROU 2**, Thorpe Mkt. Rd., towards Groveland.

This site seems to have been blanked by the Council, for some reason or another

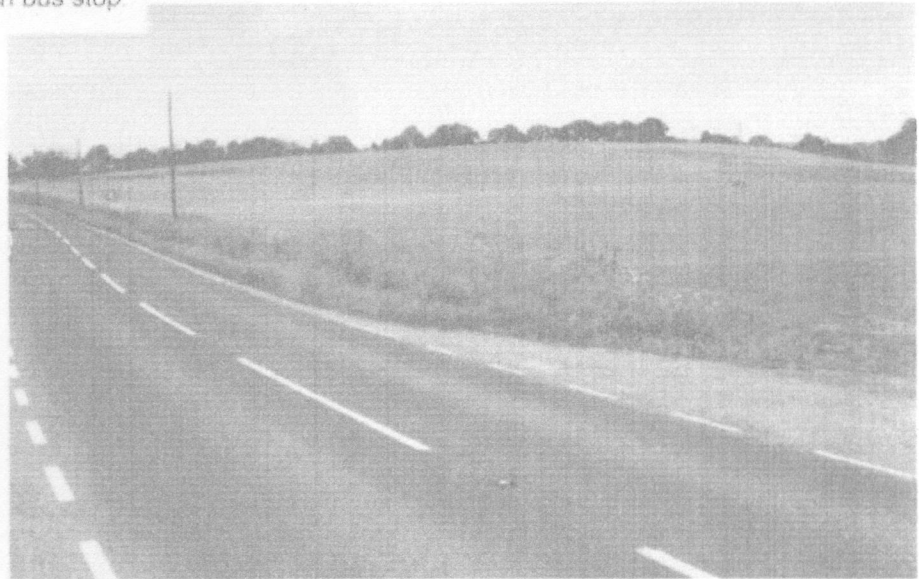
It has highways issues which can be easily overcome and would be a lot cheaper.
