Site Specific Proposals Draft Plan Schedule of Key Changes

Public Consultation Period: 5 January to 16 February 2010

Following the Site Specific Proposals Draft Plan summer consultation the comments received were considered by the Council. The council resolved that as part of the independent examination process it will request that the inspector makes some changes to the Plan to help address some of the issues raised during the consultation. These changes are included in a 'Schedule of Key Changes' document which will be available for a 6 week period of public consultation from 5 January until 16 February 2010.

Key changes are being sought in the following six settlements:

- Sheringham
- Stalham
- Aldborough
- Briston
- Little Snoring
- Weybourne

The council is only seeking comments on the changes outlined in the 'Schedule of Key Changes'. This consultation is not an opportunity to comment on the original Site Specific Proposals Draft Plan.
