**NORTH NORFOLK LANDSCAPE CHARACTER ASSESSMENT
SUPPLEMENTARY PLANNING DOCUMENT (SPD)**

The North Norfolk Landscape Character Assessment was adopted by North Norfolk District Council at its Full Council committee meeting on 30 June 2009.

The Landscape Character Assessment is a Supplementary Planning Document (SPD) which provides further information to support the implementation of Core Strategy Policies aimed at protecting and enhancing landscape character.
